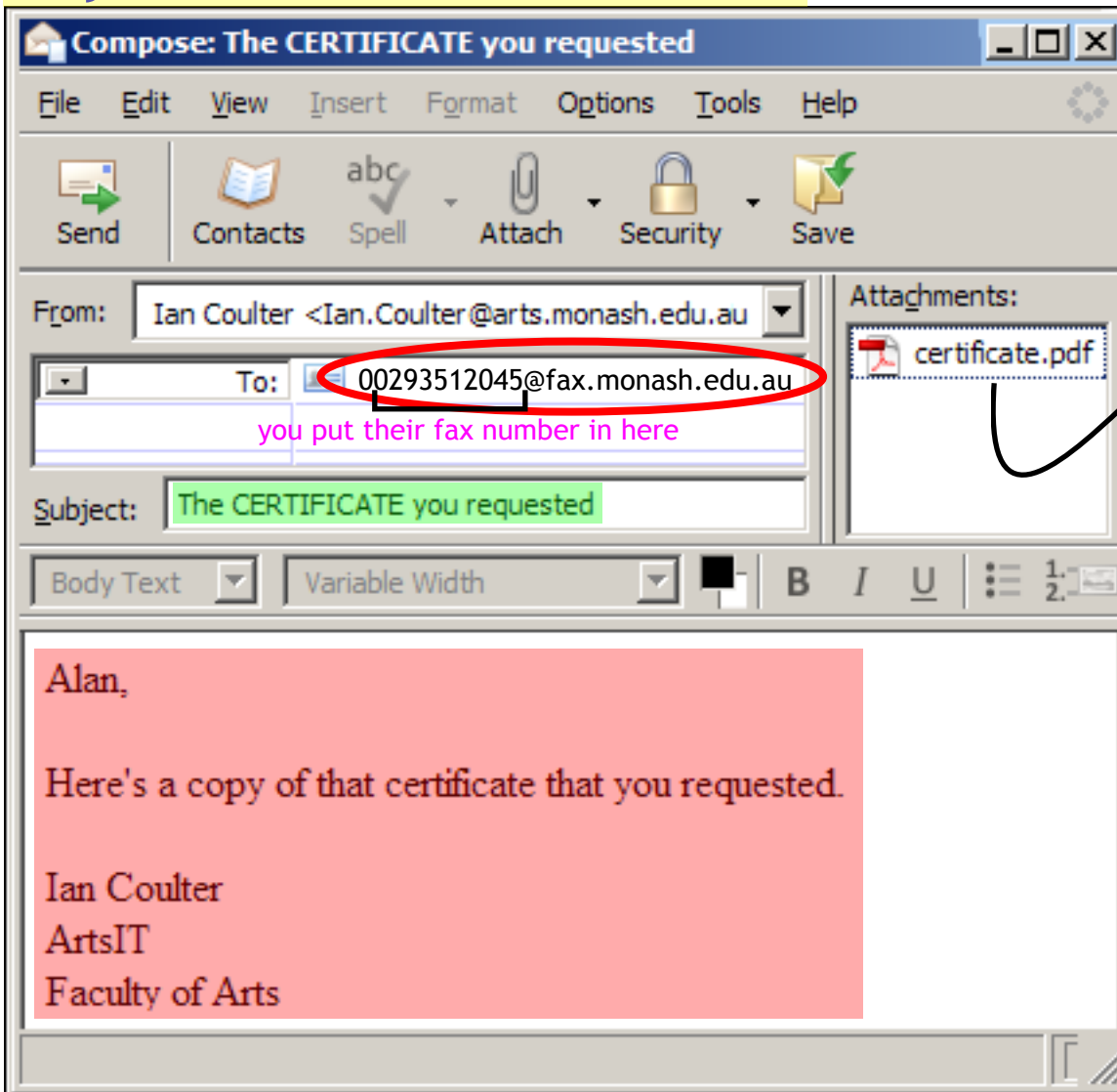


Sending a fax - examples

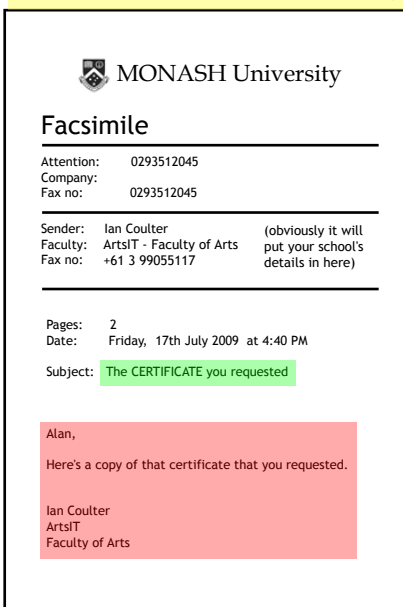
If you sent this via email...

(note: 0 to "get out" and 02 areacode)

(To a fax overseas (eg Oxford Univ)
